Fleece Tied Blankets

(1) 46' x 60' Blanket = 5 hours

(1) 21' x 15' Blanket = 4 hours

Step 1: Pick two pieces of fleece for a dog blanket

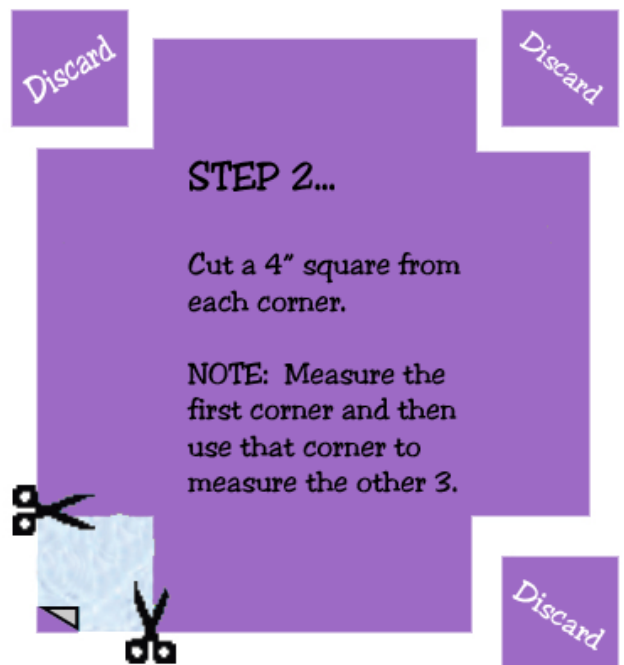
Step 2: Measure and cut each piece of fleece

Large Dog: 48' x 60'

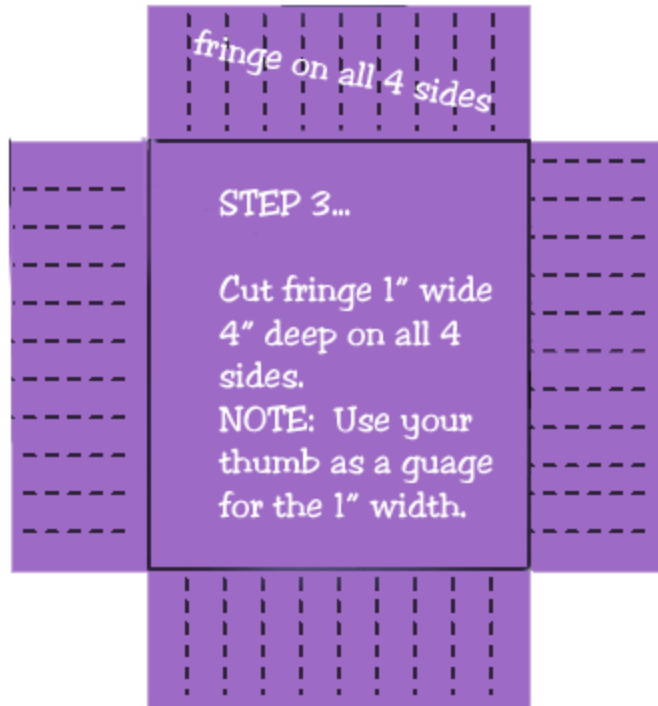
Small Dog: 21' x 15'



Step 3: Use your scissors to cut 3 inches into your fleece, one inch apart, on all four sides of the blanket *Note you will automatically create the squared-out corners as you cut



Step 4: Cut and tie each of the strips together
